



PFLAG Peachtree City Annual Report
Oct 1, 2021 – Sept 30, 2022 Accomplishments

Safe Schools/Youth

1. Met with Coweta County Schools' administrators and psychologist on how to better support LGBTQ+ students; per their request, relayed list of affirming therapists in the area
2. Raise awareness of PFLAG Peachtree City with Coweta County high school counselors and our desire to support their LGBTQ+ students/families
3. Maintain communications with gay-straight alliances in Fayette County Schools to stay aware of their status and offer any support they need
4. Held four virtual and eight in-person support meetings for middle & high school-aged youth
5. Purchased art supplies for in-person youth meetings to facilitate creative expression & interactions

Community Outreach

1. Distributed \$1,100 from our Helping Hands Fund to 3 needy individuals/families
2. Started in-person young adult (18 years to 30ish) support group
3. Held eight in-person adult support meetings (resumed in Feb.) while maintaining monthly virtual ones
4. Provided float for and marched in Peachtree City's July 4th parade
5. Answered numerous email requests for LGBTQ+ resources and individualized support
6. Posted PFLAG Peachtree City flyers in Coweta County businesses
7. Compiled list of LGBTQ+-affirming doctors and therapists to provide to those who ask
8. Printed QMed flyer with transgender health advice to distribute at meetings
9. Printed Lifesaver cards to distribute at meetings to help prevent suicide
10. Provided booth at Sept. 3 Red, White & Blue event at Drake Field in Peachtree City
11. As per request, provided June Pride talk for Arbor Terrace senior community in Peachtree City

2. Added seven new board members, including secretary & treasurer, to replace those who retired or moved away
