- Donated \$200 to and participated in Georgia Safe Schools Coalition Gay Straight Alliance Youth Summit at Agnes Scott College, Feb 2018
- Nominated J.C. Booth Middle School counselor Kristin Cristelli for 2018 GLSEN Educator of the year; she was a semi-finalist, Feb 2018
