### **Schools/Youth**

1. Held twelve 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday virtual youth group meetings; connected youth and their parents with other PFLAG chapters for additional virtual meeting options
2. Collaborated with Georgia Department of Family & Children's Services therapeutic support specialist for region 4 to facilitate support of LGBTQ+ youth in foster care
3. Communicated with East Coweta High School Gay-Straight Alliance sponsor to brainstorm how to support LGBTQ+ youth in other Coweta County schools and their parents
4. Emailed all Coweta County high school counselors about PFLAG Peachtree City and support meetings for LGBTQ+ youth and their families (no responses)

### **Community Outreach**

1. Started "Helping Hands" fund to provide financial support to LGBTQ+ people/families in our Area; distributed funds to one needy family
2. Identified new meeting place for PFLAG Henry/Spalding support group
3. Cross-posted other PFLAG chapters' virtual meetings on our Facebook page to help people find support during the COVID pandemic
4. Provided float for and marched in Peachtree City's July 3<sup>rd</sup> parade; Target employees and Southern Harm Roller Derby Dames marched/rolled with us
5. Answered numerous email requests for LGBTQ+ resources or private support
6. Two board members attended a PFLAG national "Inclusion" webinar
