



PFLAG Peachtree City Annual Report
Oct 1, 2019 – Sept 30, 2020 Accomplishments

Schools/Youth

1. Encouraged/supported students to successfully organize Gay-Straight Alliance (GSA) at McIntosh High School (MHS) for 2020-21 academic year – Sept/Oct (MHS was only Fayette county high school without one)
2. Donated \$250 to [Georgia Safe Schools Coalition](#) GSA/LGBTQ+ Youth Summit at Agnes Scott College & staffed a table with PFLAG information for their resource fair – Feb 15
3. Board member gave in-person presentation to East Coweta High School GSA – Oct 25
4. Evaluated starting a tween (ages 10-13) group, but not enough participants were identified
5. Held 5 in-person and 3 virtual youth group meetings; connected youth with other PFLAG chapters for virtual meeting options
6. Solicited youth group for lending library suggestions & purchased 13 books - June

Community Outreach

1. Provided exhibit table for Cooper Lighting Solution service fair (500 employees) – Oct 7
2. Facilitated group of 17 people to march with PFLAG Atlanta in Atlanta Pride parade - Oct 13
3. Five PFLAG Peachtree City members facilitated & participated in Festival of Kindness story time at Fayette County Public Library – March 7
4. Donated \$150 of PFLAG national publications to sustain PFLAG Henry/Spalding support group

Chapter Administration

1. Hosted 5 in-person 3rd Thursday support meetings for an average of 30 attendees with separate groups for youth and adults; pivoted to virtual adult meetings May through Sept
2. Subscribed to Slick Text service to better communicate about meetings
3. Added 16 new books/DVDs to lending library which now contains 365 resources (possibly one of largest U.S. LGBTQ+ collections)
4. Managed chapter (pflagptc.org) website, LibraryThing.com and [Facebook](https://www.facebook.com/pflagptc) pages
5. Implemented 3rd annual chapter membership drive – Oct 2019
6. Held 10 board of directors meetings
7. Three board members participated in virtual PFLAG Gulf region meeting – Aug 8
